The Steigleder Family Scholarship Fund was created in 1998 to serve the higher education needs of young people from the Fredericksburg area. It is administered by the Fredericksburg Area Builders Foundation.

Applications for scholarship grants are reviewed and awards are made on the basis of demonstrated academic and extra-curricular ability, involvement and potential. Recipients are not limited to a particular field of study. To qualify for this award, student MUST be admitted to and attend the University of Richmond.

The University of Richmond has the right to approve and confirm that all nominations meet the conditions of the scholarship criteria. Scholarship recipients must be enrolled full-time in a degree program at the University of Richmond. Additionally, recipients must be a resident of the Fredericksburg Area (Caroline County, Fredericksburg City, King George County, Orange County, Spotsylvania County, Stafford County) with preference to a resident of Caroline County, VA. The scholarship will be applied to the recipient's financial aid package at the time eligibility is confirmed. If the recipient is also receiving need-based financial aid, this scholarship will first be used to replace need-based loans and/or work study. Grant assistance will be reduced, if necessary, to keep the total of all aid within the student's demonstrated financial need.
